Edward King House, Lincoln, was formerly the deanery and is now a retreat house. It has recently been completely refurbished, and it offers 16 twin-bedded rooms, all with en-suite facilities (which can be booked for single occupancy). There is a lift to all floors, and elderly or disabled retreatants are well provided for.
